CHATEAU LA CLOTTE-CAZALIS (17.5) has belonged to the Lacoste family since 1779 and, after 40 years of being leased out, the vineyards have been reclaimed. The first vintage was 2001. There are only 5ha, with 95% Sémillon. The wine has great purity of fruit and concentration - quite superb. Both are well-worth seeking out.
